

Lewis County ARES Net Preamble (Rev 3/06/2016)

This is _____ Net Control Station for the Lewis County weekly Amateur Radio Emergency Service (ARES) Net. This net is held every Sunday evening at 1845 hours on the Baw Faw repeater courtesy of the Chehalis Valley Amateur Radio Society. The frequency is 147.06 with a PL tone of 110.9. The backup frequency is the 145.43 CVARS repeater or 146.46 simplex. This is a directed net. When checking in please give your full call sign using international standard phonetics. I will acknowledge each station as it checks in.

Pause and let the repeater drop.

This net will yield the frequency for Emergency or Priority traffic at any time. Is any station holding Emergency or Priority traffic, your call sign only please?

Pause and let the repeater drop.

The purpose of this net is operator and net controller training for the Amateur Radio Emergency Service in Lewis County and the Baw Faw repeater coverage area, including message handling and training in use of the National Traffic System. This net also provides informational and public service announcements. You do not need to be a member of ARES to check into the net. In the event of an actual emergency, a Lewis County Emergency Net will be established on this frequency. Any station with announcements or radiograms, list your traffic when you check in.

Pause and let the repeater drop.

Visitors will be picked up in sequence after the regular members of the net. Emergency powered or mobile Lewis County ARES Team members, your call sign now please.
